The LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green Building Rating System provides a standard for defining an environmentally friendly, sustainable, "green" building. Points are awarded to construction projects based on building characteristics like water savings, energy efficiency, indoor air quality, and the types of building materials used. The Euclid Chemical Company manufactures many products that can contribute points toward the LEED certification of a building.

Speed Crete Red Line is manufactured in Kirkland IL and therefore would contribute to a building's LEED point calculation under category "Local/Regional Materials Manufactured Locally" (MR Credit 5.1) for projects within a 500-mile radius of Kirkland IL. The VOC of Speed Crete Red Line is 0 g/l, and it does not contain any recycled materials.
